Completion of secondary school is usually required.

Completion of a three to five-year apprenticeship program or a combination of over five years of work experience in the trade and some high school, college or industry courses in plumbing is usually required to be eligible for trade certification.

Trade certification for plumbing is mandatory in Ontario.
